- Box of **pre-sharpened** pencils
- Eraser caps

(bring a sock to use as an eraser!)
- Pack of markers

- Ear buds or headphones for computer use
- Box of tissues
- Clorox wipes

# Third Grade Supply List

The most important element of success in school is responsibility. In order to become responsible, students must be organized. In an effort to assist this process, I suggest third grade students have the following items when they begin school in August.

- Plastic shoe box with a lid (box should be no more than 6 inches high) This is their supply box used to hold your child's pencils, crayons, scissors, etc. There is no reason to purchase pencil boxes. \*these can be found at Dollar General for \$2.00\*
- 2 packages of loose leaf notebook paper
- 3 boxes of pencils (mechanical pencils are not suggested, but can be used)
- 2 pairs of scissors
- 3 boxes of crayons
- 1 box of markers and box of colored pencils
- 6 glue sticks
- 4 dry erase markers
- 2 folders
- 2 composition/spiral notebooks (journals)
- Binder
- 1 package of tabs
- Eraser for dry erase markers (I have found that a wash cloth works great)
- Pair of headphones for computer use (this way your child has their own pair to use and stops the spreading of lice)

Please know that I ask for extra supplies in the beginning of the year since the cost of supplies is lower then. These extra supplies are placed in a tub with your child's name on them so they can restock when needed.
